### Bamboo Lake

## Route FOR Relaxation



### 1 Banyan Park

Aside from the historic granite school monument, the banyan tree is to form a natural environment on campus.



### 2 Han Garden

As a token of gratitude to honor Dr. Han Wei, the garden was set up for later generations to remember and commemorate his contributions.



### 3 Triangle Garden

The plants in Triangle Park are diverse, and the best-known one is Taiwan cow-tail fir, a native species of Taiwan.



### 4 Shen Nong Po

Along the slope, a huge boulder was inscribed by Mr. Deng Ao-han in 1967, which encourages students to study hard.



### 5 Junjianyan

Junjianyan is close to the small hills of Shipai and Tianmu, which is also the main attraction of the Jinjianyan Mountain Trail.



### 6 Mountain-top Sports ground

Located at the highest point of the campus, it follows the winding hills of campus as it goes up stairs through school buildings and natural trails.

### 1 Spring Breeze

"Spring Breeze" gives people a youthful image of flying butterflies, implying that it brings messages of love and life.



### 2 Brilliant Life

The fusion of the "human" shape and "flower" shape constitutes a three-in-one momentum of "heaven, earth, and human".



### 3 Pause and Extension in Life

Located on the periphery of campus, the work is inspired by cells, with polygonal tessellation extending limitlessly on its surface.

Library, Information and Research Bldg.

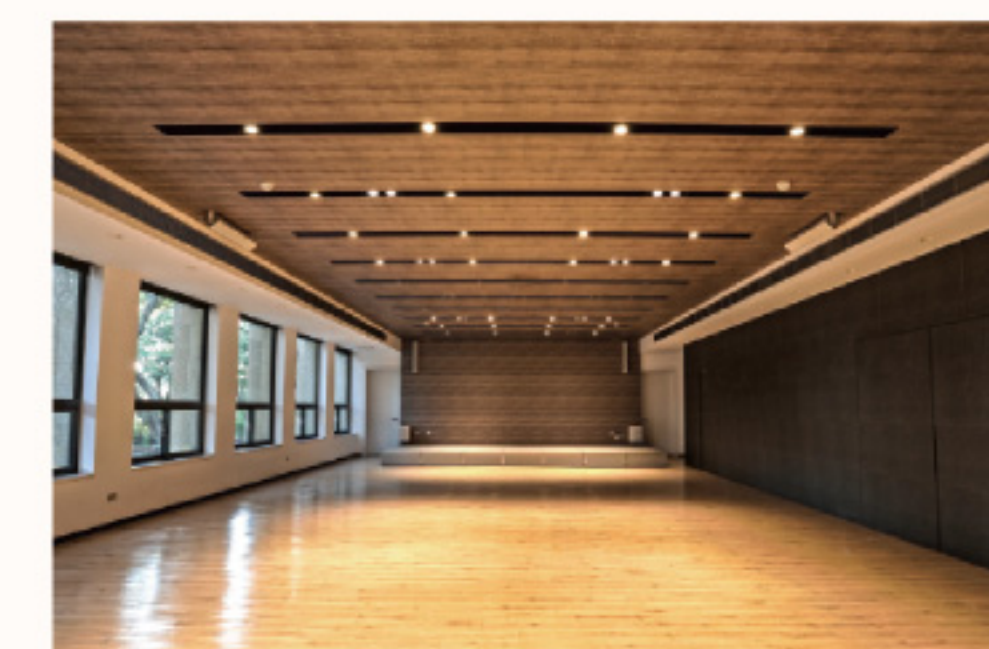
The gallery provides viewers with an outline of the university's establishment, transformation and expansion, achievement and visions.

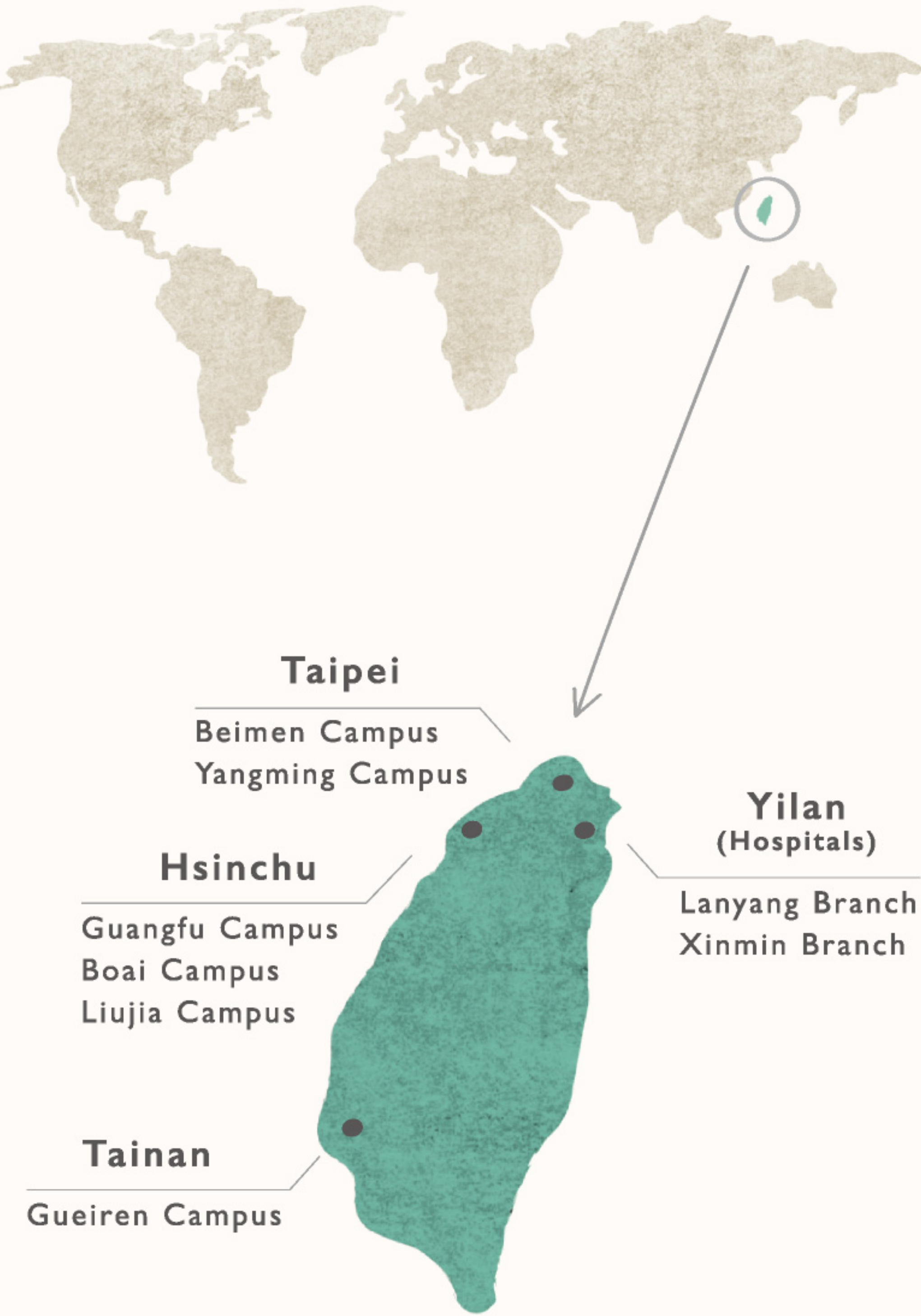

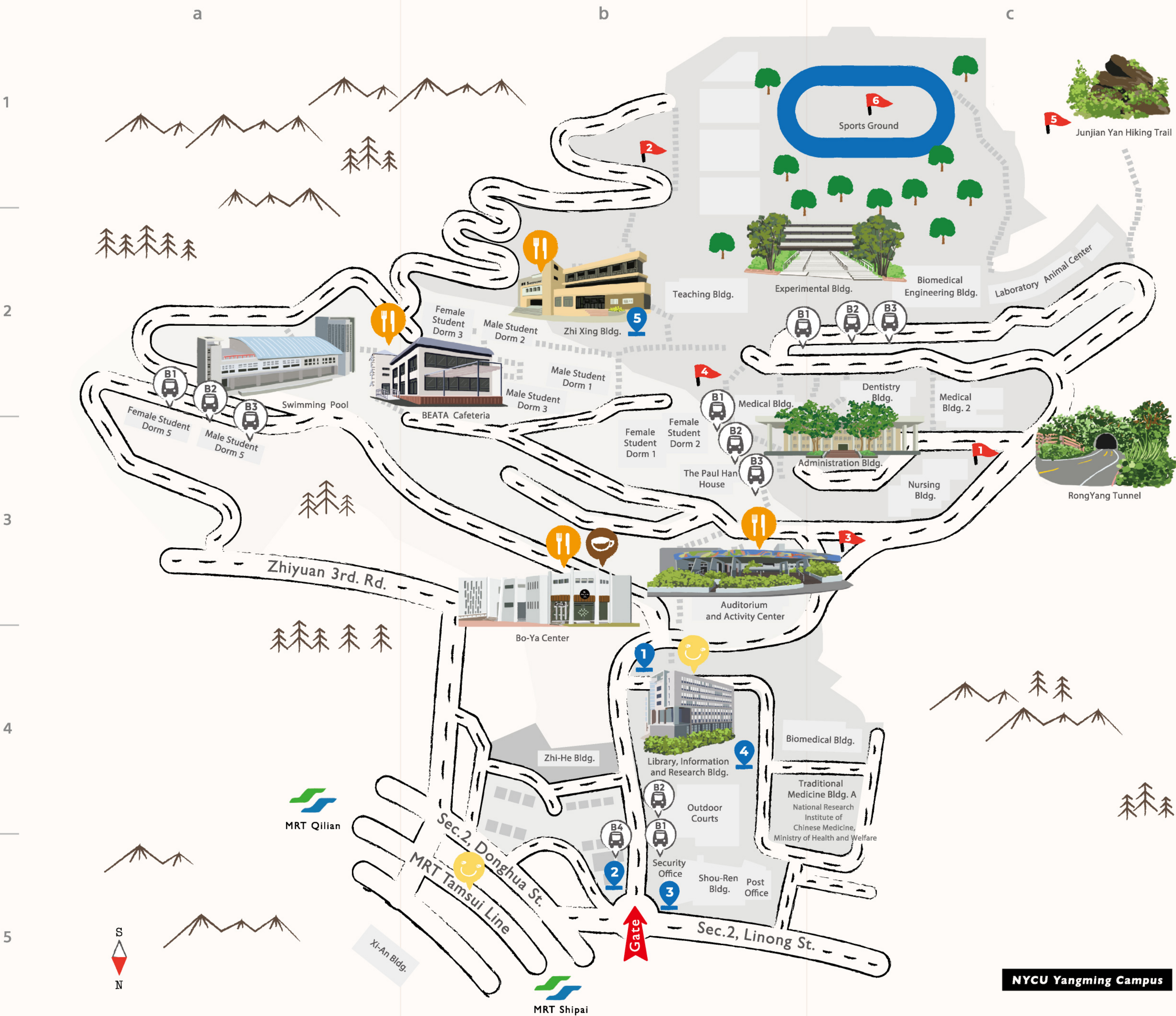

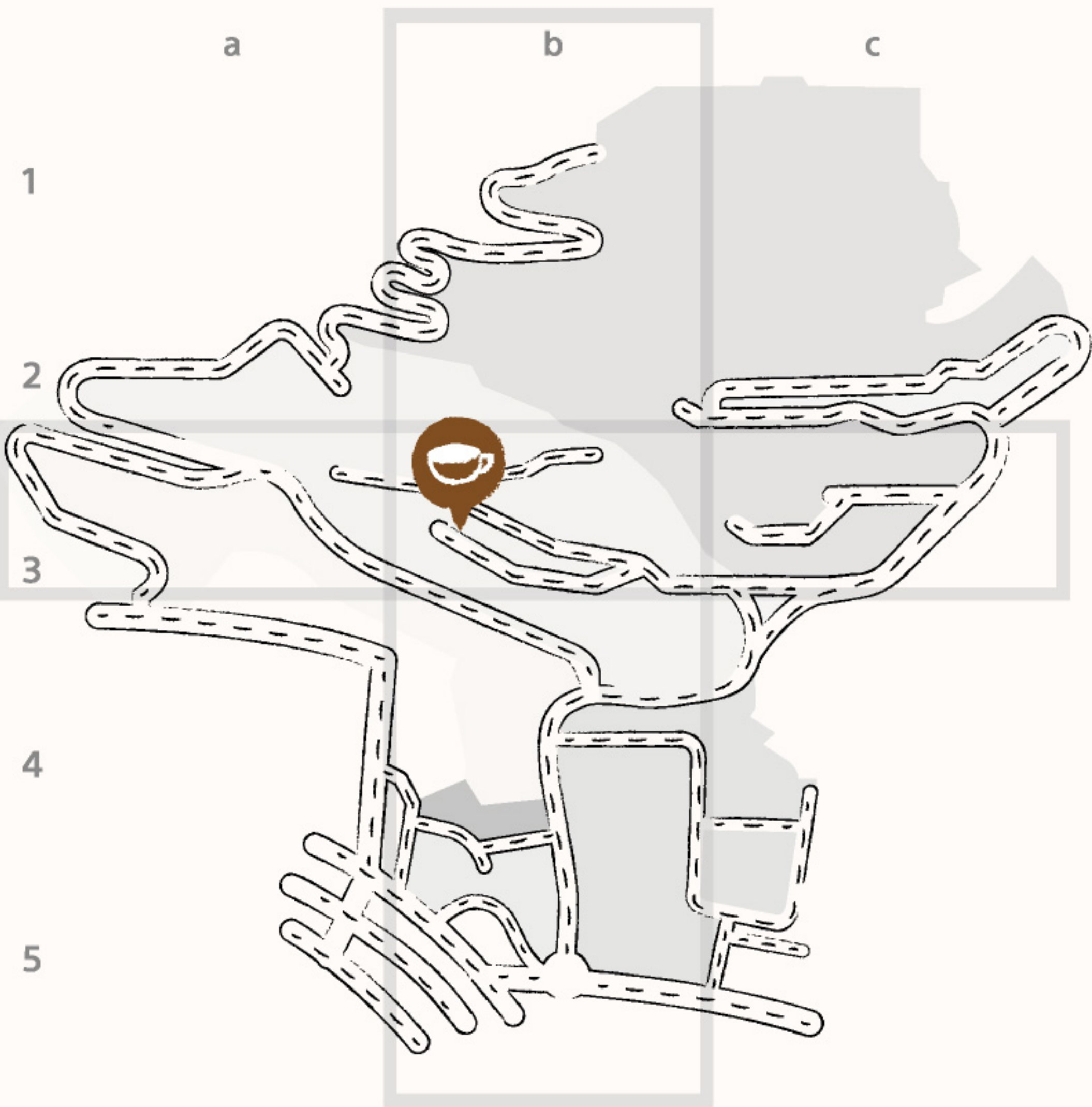
